April 13 Graduation pictures will be taken at school (gowns will be worn).

May 14 Chromebook Return Day--All chromebooks must be turned into Mr. Hines. They will be checked and any damage repair costs will be invoiced to the parent. Any chromebooks/chargers not returned will be billed to students' accounts.

Final day to turn in Parent Volunteer Hours or be invoiced a fee per missing hour.

May 16 LAST SCHOOL DAY FOR 9TH GRADERS WHO ARE NOT REQUIRED TO TAKE SEMESTER TESTS.

Students are not required to wear their school uniforms, but should wear clothes they can work in, as this will in part be a day of service work. Graduation practice will be Wednesday when they return from their service project. The 9th graders' last Mass/prayer service of the school year will be that morning at our regular time (8:50 a.m.) before they leave. Parents are invited to attend the Mass.

May 17 SEMESTER TEST DAY for 9th grade only. All 9th graders who are required to take any semester tests will be given a schedule of testing periods and should report for any necessary tests.

May 20 Awards Banquet, 5 p.m. All 9th grade students and families are invited to this meal, video celebration of

the school year, and award presentation. Student meals will be provided, all others must purchase a ticket for \$12 (form attached). Tag Day guidelines apply for students, church attire is appropriate. We hope that all of our graduates are able to attend this meal in their honor.

Commemorative bricks may be ordered for graduates to be placed in the courtyard and yearbook ads may be ordered to honor graduates in our 2017/18 yearbooks, which will be distributed at Tailgate Trinity in August. These are optional (form attached).

Pictures to be included should span students' years at Trinity, and optimally should contain more than one student. No selfies will be included!
